## **Home Page**

The homepage is where you will start each time you go to <https://www.myodesie.com>

The navigation bar at the top of the homepage is where you will access all the different areas of odesie.® The bar will always be accessible, no matter where your learning journey takes you.

## **Changing Your Password**

While you are logged in, go to MENU, then ACCOUNT. Here, you can change your email address, your first and last name, as well as your password. Once you have changed your password, the one received in your registration email will no longer work.

## **Catalog**

Content is sold in several different ways. Industrial Training Programs make it easy to purchase content that is specific to a particular craft; while in our Off the Shelf Content area, you can purchase an entire series or subject area, or pick and choose specific modules. Simply click on the shopping cart icon to add the selection to your cart, then click View Cart to finish your transaction. You must be a registered, logged in user to make purchases.

## **Industrial Wiki**

## **Learning Activities**

To open an activity, click on the thumbnail. The Unity Web Player must be installed for an activity to run. Unity does not work on the Google Chrome web browser.

## **Video Archive**

The Video Archive showcases industrial-based videos in various topics. You do not have to be a logged in user to watch the videos. However, if you would like to leave a comment or give a rating, you will be prompted to log in.

Click the thumbnail of the video you would like to view, then click the play button in the middle of the video screen.

## **Forum**
